Spurgeon (1834-1892) was a British Baptist preacher who remains highly influential among Christians of different denominations, among whom he is still known as the 'Prince of Preachers.' He preached his first sermon, from 1 Peter 2:7, in 1851 at 16 and became pastor of the Church in Waterbeach in 1852. He published more than 1,900 different sermons and preached to around 10,000,000 people during his lifetime. In addition, Spurgeon was a prolific author of many types of works including an autobiography, a commentary, books on prayer, a devotional, a magazine, poetry, hymnist and more. Many sermons were transcribed as he spoke and were later translated into many languages. Arguably, no other author, Christian or otherwise, has more material in print than C.H. Spurgeon. SPANISH BIO: Charles H. Spurgeon (1834-1892), nacio en Inglaterra, y fue un predicador bautista que se mantuvo muy influyente entre cristianos de diferentes denominaciones, los cuales todavia lo conocen como 'El principe de los predicadores'. El predico su primer sermon en 1851 a los dieciseis anos y paso a ser pastor de la iglesia en Waterbeach en 1852. Publico mas de 1,900 sermones y predico a 10, 000,000 de personas durante su vida. Ademas, Spurgeon fue un autor prolifico de una variedad de obras, incluyendo una autobiografia, un comentario biblico, libros acerca de la oracion, un devocional, una revista, poesia, himnos y mas.
